A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING REQUIRED COVERAGES FOR REPRODUCTIVE SERVICES 102 FOR HEALTH INSURANCE POLICIES.

Bill Summary

Health Care Task Force. The bill requires entities issuing individual sickness and accident insurance polices in this state to provide the same coverage for maternity care as is currently mandated for all group sickness and accident insurance policies. The bill also requires both individual and group policies to provide coverage for pregnancy 3rd Reading Unam ended

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management, including contraceptive counseling, drugs, and devices. The bill excludes abortion procedures and services from pregnancy management.

Mandatory coverage provisions - definitions. 5 (3) Maternity coverage. (a) (I) All group sickness and accident 6 insurance policies providing coverage within the state and issued to an 7 employer by an entity subject to the provisions of part 2 of this article, 8 and all group health service contracts issued by an entity subject to the 9 provisions of part 3 or 4 of this article and issued to an employer, _____ 10 _ shall insure against the expense of normal pregnancy and childbirth or provide coverage for maternity care therefor ___ in the same manner as 11 12 any other sickness, injury, disease, or condition is otherwise covered 13 under the policy or contract. GROUP SICKNESS AND ACCIDENT policies or 14 contracts shall not exclude coverage for pregnancy and delivery expenses 15 on the grounds that pregnancy was a preexisting condition. AN ENTITY 16 THAT OFFERS INDIVIDUAL SICKNESS AND ACCIDENT INSURANCE POLICIES 17 SUBJECT TO PART 2 OF THIS ARTICLE, EXCEPT SUPPLEMENTAL POLICIES 18 COVERING A SPECIFIED DISEASE OR OTHER LIMITED BENEFIT, SHALL OFFER 19 AT LEAST ONE POLICY THAT INCLUDES COVERAGE FOR MATERNITY CARE 20 IN THE SAME MANNER AS ANY OTHER SICKNESS, INJURY, DISEASE, OR 21 CONDITION THAT IS COVERED IN THE POLICY AND ALL INDIVIDUAL 22 SICKNESS AND ACCIDENT POLICIES, EXCEPT SUPPLEMENTAL POLICIES 23 COVERING A SPECIFIED DISEASE OR OTHER LIMITED BENEFIT, SHALL 24 PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR CONTRACEPTION.

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1	SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - specified effective date
2	- applicability. (1) This act shall take effect January 1, 2011; except
3	that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V
4	of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this
5	act within the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general
6	assembly, then the act, item, section, or part shall not take effect unless
7	approved by the people at the general election to be held in November,
8	2010, and shall take effect on January 1, 2011, or on the date of the
9	official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor, whichever is

12	and accident insurance policies issued or renewed on or after the
13	applicable effective date of this act.

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
