A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING THE USE OF MONEYS IN THE SUPPLEMENTAL OLD AGE**
102 **PENSION HEALTH AND MEDICAL CARE FUND TO PAY FOR**
103 **SERVICES RECEIVED BY CERTAIN PERSONS IN THE STATE**
104 **MEDICAID PROGRAM, AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION**

year 2010-11 and up to \$3,000,000 in fiscal year 2011-12 of moneys in the supplemental old age pension health and medical care fund to be used to offset general fund costs for state medicaid program services for persons 65 years of age or older.

The provisions repeal on July 1, 2012.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** 25.5-2-101 (3) (b) (III), Colorado Revised Statutes,
3 is amended, and the said 25.5-2-101 (3) (b) is further amended BY THE
4 ADDITION OF THE FOLLOWING NEW SUBPARAGRAPHS, to read:

5 **25.5-2-101. Old age pension health and medical care fund -**
6 **supplemental old age pension health and medical care fund - cash**
7 **system of accounting - legislative declaration - rules - repeal.**

8 (3) (b) (III) ~~This paragraph (b) is repealed, effective July 1, 2010.~~

9 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION OF PARAGRAPH (a) OF THIS
10 SUBSECTION (3) TO THE CONTRARY, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2010-11, UP TO
11 FOUR MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS FROM THE
12 SUPPLEMENTAL OLD AGE PENSION HEALTH AND MEDICAL CARE FUND MAY
13 BE USED TO OFFSET GENERAL FUND COSTS FOR PERSONS SIXTY-FIVE YEARS
14 OF AGE OR OLDER WHO ARE SERVED THROUGH THE STATE MEDICAID
15 PROGRAM.

16 (IV) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION OF PARAGRAPH (a) OF
17 THIS SUBSECTION (3) TO THE CONTRARY, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2011-12, UP TO
18 THREE MILLION DOLLARS FROM THE SUPPLEMENTAL OLD AGE PENSION
19 HEALTH AND MEDICAL CARE FUND MAY BE USED TO OFFSET GENERAL

23 **SECTION 2. Appropriation - adjustments in 2010 long bill.**

1 (1) For the implementation of this act, appropriations in the annual
2 general appropriation act to the department of health care policy and
3 financing, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2010, shall be adjusted as
4 follows:

5 (a) The general fund appropriation for medical service premiums
6 is decreased by four million eight hundred fifty thousand dollars
7 (\$4,850,000).

8 (b) The cash funds appropriation for medical service premiums is
9 increased by four million eight hundred fifty thousand dollars
10 (\$4,850,000). Said sum shall be from the supplemental old age pension
11 health and medical care fund created in section 25.5-2-101 (3) (a),
12 Colorado Revised Statutes.

13 **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
14 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
15 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
