Bill Summary

Legislative Audit Committee. Extends from 90 to 120 days the deadline for the review of grievance petitions by the state personnel board.

2 SECTION 1. 24-50-123 (3), Colorado Revised Statutes, is
3 amended to read:

4 24-50-123. Grievances - review. (3) The decision of the 5 appointing authority shall be final; except that an employee may petition 6 the board for review. The board may grant the petition only when it 7 appears that the decision of the appointing authority violates an 8 employee's rights under the federal or state constitution, part 4 of article 9 34 of this title, article 50.5 of this title, or the grievance procedures 10 adopted pursuant to subsection (1) of this section. The board shall review 11 and summarily grant or deny a petition within ninety ONE HUNDRED 12 TWENTY days of receipt of the petition; except that petitions filed with the 13 board that result in an investigation pursuant to section 24-50-125.3 or 14 24-50.5-104 are exempt from the ninety-day ONE-HUNDRED-TWENTY-DAY 15 review requirement. Any petition granted shall be determined in 16 accordance with section 24-50-125.4.

17 SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date -18 **applicability.** (1) This act shall take effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day 19 following the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment 20 of the general assembly (August 11, 2010, if adjournment sine die is on 21 May 12, 2010); except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to 22 section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an 23 item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, 24 section, or part shall not take effect unless approved by the people at the 25 general election to be held in November 2010 and shall take effect on the 26 date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.

(2) The provisions of this act shall apply to petitions filed on or
 after the applicable effective date of this act.
