**Capital Development Committee.** The bill adds the board of trustees for Metropolitan state college of Denver to the list of higher education governing boards that may exercise the power of eminent domain.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2           **SECTION 1.** 38-2-105, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended  
3 to read:

4           **38-2-105. Higher education governing boards have right of**  
5 **eminent domain.** The regents of the university of Colorado, the board  
6 of governors of the Colorado state university system for Colorado state  
7 university and Colorado state university - Pueblo, the board of trustees for  
8 Fort Lewis college, the board of trustees of the Colorado school of mines,  
9 the board of trustees for the university of northern Colorado, the board of  
10 trustees for Adams state college, the board of trustees for Mesa state  
11 college, ~~and~~ the board of trustees for Western state college of Colorado,  
12 AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR METROPOLITAN STATE COLLEGE OF  
13 DENVER have the power to acquire real property, which they may deem  
14 necessary, by the exercise of eminent domain through condemnation  
15 proceedings in accordance with law.

16           **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
17 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
18 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
