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A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING APPLICATIONS FOR HOME- AND COMMUNITY-BASED  
102 SERVICES WAIVERS FOR CHILDREN AS PART OF THE MEDICAID  
103 ELIGIBILITY MODERNIZATION.

**Interim Committee on the Developmental Disability Waiting List.** As part of the medicaid eligibility modernization, the bill authorizes the department of health care policy and financing to create a universal application or single point of entry for home- and community-based

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1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2           **SECTION 1.** 25.5-4-205 (1), Colorado Revised Statutes, is  
3 amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW PARAGRAPH to read:

4           **25.5-4-205. Application - verification of eligibility -**  
5 **demonstration project - rules - repeal.** (1) (a.7) AS PART OF THE  
6 MEDICAID ELIGIBILITY MODERNIZATION, THE DEPARTMENT IS AUTHORIZED  
7 TO CREATE A UNIVERSAL APPLICATION OR SINGLE POINT OF ENTRY FOR  
8 HOME- AND COMMUNITY-BASED SERVICES WAIVERS FOR CHILDREN.

9           **SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act  
10 shall take effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the  
11 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August  
12 11, 2010, if adjournment sine die is on May 12, 2010); except that, if a  
13 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the  
14 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act  
15 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part shall not take effect  
16 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in  
17 November 2010 and shall take effect on the date of the official  
18 declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
