A BILL FOR AN ACT

CONCERNING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF CERTAIN RECOMMENDATIONS
OF THE COUNTY ELECTED OFFICIALS' SALARY COMMISSION.

Bill Summary

The bill implements 2 of the requests made by the county elected officials' salary commission in its 2010 report to the general assembly.

Section 1 of the bill changes the timing and frequency of when the commission will meet and submit its report to the general assembly.
