Bill Summary

The bill directs the Colorado state forest service to establish training and certification standards for users of prescribed fire, including certified burner and noncertified burner designations, recommended processes for certified burners to conduct a prescribed fire, recommended SENATE 3rd Reading Unam ended February 22, 2010

Healthy forests - vibrant communities - funds 5 created. (6) Community watershed restoration. (a) In order to 6 support communities and land managers in moving from risk reduction 7 to long-term ecological restoration so that the underlying condition of 8 Colorado's forests supports a variety of values, particularly public water 9 supply and high-quality wildlife habitat, the forest service shall: 10 (III) ESTABLISH TRAINING AND CERTIFICATION STANDARDS FOR 11 USERS OF PRESCRIBED FIRE IN CONSULTATION WITH THE COLORADO 12 PRESCRIBED FIRE COUNCIL OR AN ANALOGOUS SUCCESSOR ORGANIZATION. 13 THE FOREST SERVICE MAY ALSO CONSULT WITH LOCAL FIRE 14 JURISDICTIONS. THE STANDARDS SHALL: 15 (A) CREATE CERTIFIED BURNER AND NONCERTIFIED BURNER 16 DESIGNATIONS FOR USERS OF PRESCRIBED FIRE ON PRIVATE AND 17 NONFEDERAL LAND: 18 (B) ESTABLISH REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTIFIED BURNERS TO 19 CONDUCT LAWFUL ACTIVITIES PURSUANT TO AUTHORIZATION UNDER 20 SECTION 18-13-109(2)(b)(IV), C.R.S., REGARDING FIRING OF WOODS OR 21 PRAIRIE; 22 (C) IDENTIFY PROCESSES AND PROCEDURES FOR CERTIFIED 23

- 9 SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
 10 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
 11 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
