TITLE: CONCERNING THE REPEAL OF THE COMMUNITY ACCOUNTABILITY PROGRAM ADVISORY BOARD.**Summary of Legislation**

The bill repeals the Community Accountability Program Advisory Board. The board was created to advise the Community Accountability Program in the Division of Youth Corrections in the Department of Human Services on a range of issues such as selection criteria for juveniles sentenced to the program, use of the program as a sentencing option, policy issues, and support services. The bill was signed into law by the Governor on March 21, 2011, and the board is repealed as of August 10, 2011, assuming no referendum petition is filed.

Assessment

The bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact. The advisory board has not received funding since FY 2002-03 and repealing the board will not affect state revenue and expenditures.
