Summary of Legislation

As amended by the House Judiciary Committee, this bill directs the Department of Revenue to include requirements for special packaging and labeling for medical marijuana-infused products in its rulemaking for the regulation of medical marijuana. The packaging must be significantly difficult for children under the age of five to open, and not allow the product to be seen without opening the packaging material. The rules may also require the product to be labeled "Medicinal product - not for use by children."

State Expenditures

The Department of Revenue will incorporate these requirements into their rulemaking process. The fiscal note assumes this can be accomplished within existing appropriations for the regulation of medical marijuana.
