TITLE: CONCERNING INTERSTATE COMPACTS FOR ADULT CRIMINAL SUPERVISION.

Summary of Legislation

This bill changes the crime of unauthorized residency by an adult offender from another state in order to reflect the provisions of the Interstate Compact for Adult Offender Supervision, to which Colorado is a signatory. Additionally, the Uniform Act for Out-of-state Parolee Supervision is repealed. The bill was signed into law by the Governor and took effect on March 1, 2011.

Assessment

The bill modifies statutory language, but will not substantially affect the revenues or expenditures of any state agency. As such, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.
