JBC Staff Concurrence with Legislative Council Staff Fiscal Note

Concurs **Does Not Concur** **Updated Analysis**

Amendments/Appropriation Status

Staff concurs with the Legislative Council Staff Revised Fiscal Note assessment that S.B. 11-055 will increase state expenditures by more than \$5,000 for state agencies to post notices and to reimburse local governments using magnetometers and scanners. However, the level of expenditures incurred by each state agency is unclear. Additionally, it is unclear which state agency would incur costs in reimbursing local governments for their compliance with the provisions of the bill. For these reasons, coupled with the small dollar amount of each agency's anticipated expenditures, staff has not prepared an appropriations clause amendment for the bill.

Bill Sponsor Amendments

Sponsor amendment **L.005** (attached) accomplishes the following:

- Removes the provision requiring the state to reimburse local governments for expenditures incurred complying with the legislation;
- clarifies the contents of required notices to be posted at the point of entry to a security area containing a magnetometer or scanner; and
- requires the bill to be implemented within existing resources.
