**TITLE:** CONCERNING THE CONGRESSIONAL REDISTRICTING OF COLORADO.**Summary of Legislation**

The bill establishes the boundaries for Colorado's seven congressional districts, which are apportioned to the state following the 2010 federal census. The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor or becoming law without his signature. The new congressional districts would first apply to the 2012 general election and remain in effect until congressional districts are again reapportioned.

**Assessment**

Current law requires that the state redraw congressional district boundaries following the decennial census. The bill fulfills this requirement. Therefore, it is assessed as having no fiscal impact.
