## **Summary of Legislation**

The Auraria Higher Education Center is a combined campus comprised of three institutions; the University of Colorado at Denver, Metropolitan State College of Denver, and the Community College of Denver. The campus is governed by the Auraria Board, which is composed of representatives from each institution, and assisted by a student advisory committee and a faculty advisory committee. This bill provides an appointment process for filling vacancies on either of the advisory committees. The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature.

## Assessment

The bill sets a process for replacing members of two specific advisory committees working with the Auraria Board. There are no changes in state expenditures or revenues as a result of the bill and it is assessed as having no fiscal impact.
