8	PREVIOUS TWELVE MONTHS, A SMALL GROUP HEALTH BENEFIT PLAN
9	PROVIDING COVERAGE TO ITS EMPLOYEES UNDER THIS ARTICLE MAY
10	REIMBURSE AN EMPLOYEE, WHETHER THROUGH WAGE ADJUSTMENTS OR
11	HEALTH REIMBURSEMENT ARRANGEMENTS, FOR ANY PORTION OF THE
12	PREMIUM FOR A HEALTH COVERAGE PLAN.
13	SECTION 2. Effective date - applicability. This act shall take
14	effect upon passage and shall apply to payments or reimbursements to
15	employees of small employers for the costs of health insurance premiums
16	on or after said date.
17	SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
18	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
19	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.".

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
