# CONCERNING THE EXPANSION OF THE SCOPE OF PRACTICE FOR FIVE-POINT NADA AURICULAR ACUPUNCTURE TO ADDITIONAL

#### 103 TRAINED HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONALS.

#### **Bill Summary**

A BILL FOR AN ACT

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. If this bill passes third reading in the house of introduction, a bill summary that applies to the reengrossed version of this bill will be available at http://www.leg.state.co.us/billsummaries.)

Five-point NADA auricular acupuncture is acupuncture done on the ear that is often used to treat substance abuse, mental health, and behavioral health disorders. ("NADA" stands for "National Acupuncture Detoxification Association".) Currently, acupuncturists are the only group allowed to perform this protocol. The bill allows chiropractors, physicians, physician assistants, nurses, mental health professionals, and psychiatric technicians to perform 5-point NADA auricular acupuncture if they have successfully completed the proper training.
