**Summary of Amendments Made to the Bill After the 02/08/11 Legislative Council Staff Fiscal Note Was Prepared (Amended by the House Health and Environment Committee 02/08/11)**

The House Health and Environment Committee Report made the following changes to the bill:

- Clarified that chiropractors, physicians, physician assistants, nurses, psychiatric technicians, and mental health professionals must use the National Acupuncture Detoxification Association (NADA) training program;
- Required physician assistants, nurses, psychiatric technicians, and mental health workers perform acupuncture under indirect supervision of a NADA-certified acupuncturist, physician or NADA trainer; and,
- Defined indirect supervision.
