Bill Summary

The contribution via tax checkoff for the Colorado healthy rivers fund is extended to the 2020 tax year.

2 SECTION 1. 39-22-2402, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended
3 to read:

39-22-2402. Voluntary contribution designation - procedure.
For income tax years commencing on or after January 1, 2008, but prior
to January 1, 2011 2016, the Colorado state individual income tax return
form shall contain a line whereby each individual taxpayer may designate
the amount of the contribution, if any, the individual wishes to make to
the Colorado healthy rivers fund created in section 39-22-2403.

10 SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 11 shall take effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 12 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 13 10, 2011, if adjournment sine die is on May 11, 2011); except that, if a 14 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the 15 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act 16 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part shall not take effect 17 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 18 November 2012 and shall take effect on the date of the official 19 declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
