Summary of Legislation

HB11-1116 requires local governments to obtain voter approval prior to providing, contracting to provide, or requiring residents of a local government to pay fees for waste services. The ballot must include a description of the proposed service as well as the cost of the service.

Local Government Impact

The bill does not impact the way local governments provide existing waste services to residents. However, since voter approval is required before a local government can change the way that waste services are provided to residents, the bill is assessed as having a local conditional fiscal impact. Local election costs will vary by location.
