## **Summary of Legislation**

This bill allows taxicabs operating in the city and county of Denver to pick up passengers at any point in the state of Colorado when the taxicab has dropped passengers off near that point. The taxicab must transport the passengers back to the taxicab's authorized area.

## **State Expenditures**

This bill has a minimal impact on the workload of the Colorado Public Utilities Commission (PUC), but no appropriations are required. The PUC will modify its rules and update the tariffs for the four taxi companies affected by the bill. This can be accomplished within existing appropriations.
