	HB11-1120 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:
1 2	Amend printed bill, strike everything below the enacting clause and substitute:
3 4 5	" <b>SECTION 1. Repeal.</b> 24-33.5-1202 (13.3) and (13.7), Colorado Revised Statutes, as they will become effective July 1, 2011, are repealed as follows:
6 7	<b>24-33.5-1202. Definitions.</b> As used in this part 12, unless the context otherwise requires:
8 9 10 11 12 13 14 15	(13.3) "Sprinkler fitter" means a person other than an apprentice who is registered with the administrator and who installs fire suppression systems. "Sprinkler fitter" does not include a person who performs maintenance and repair on fire suppression systems as a part of his or her employment. A sprinkler fitter does not include a person who performs work exclusively on cross-connection control devices or a person who performs work exclusively on an underground system. "Sprinkler fitter" does not include a person performing work on his or her own home.
16 17 18 19 20	(13.7) "Sprinkler fitter apprenticeship program" means an apprenticeship training program that is registered with either the office of apprenticeship training, employer and labor services in the employment and training administration in the United States department of labor or a state apprenticeship agency in accordance with the requirements of 29

1 2 3 4	CFR 29.1 et seq., or other similar apprentice program approved by the administrator, and consists of a minimum of eight thousand hours of documented practical work experience on fire suppression systems, combined with a minimum of seven hundred hours of related instruction,
5	including classroom or shop instruction, in the sprinkler fitter trade.
6 7	<b>SECTION 2. Repeal.</b> 24-33.5-1206.7, Colorado Revised Statutes, as it will become effective July 1, 2011, is repealed as follows:
8	24-33.5-1206.7. Sprinkler fitters - registration required - rules.
9	(1) No person shall act, assume to act, or advertise as a sprinkler fitter
10	who is not registered with the administrator.
11	(2) A registered sprinkler fitter shall obtain any locally required
12	licenses or permits and comply with local building codes.
13	(3) In order to register with the administrator, a sprinkler fitter
14	shall pay a fee as determined by the administrator and shall:
15	(a) Provide evidence demonstrating that he or she successfully
16	completed a sprinkler fitter apprenticeship program and take and pass an
17	examination established and approved by the administrator;
18	(b) Complete an application for registration by reciprocity
19	established by rules of the administrator that demonstrates competent
20	evidence that the applicant is currently authorized to practice as a
21	sprinkler fitter in another state that has established qualification
22	requirements substantially similar to, or greater than, the requirements
23	established in this section or by rule of the administrator;
24	(c) Provide evidence demonstrating that he or she performed at
25	least eight thousand hours of documented practical work experience on
26	fire suppression systems within the past five years; or
27	(d) Otherwise demonstrate competency as a sprinkler fitter as
28	determined by the administrator.
29	(4) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (3) of this
30	section, a person who is enrolled in a sprinkler fitter apprenticeship
31	program may perform work on a fire suppression system under the direct

supervision of and in the immediate presence of a sprinkler fitter.

1	(5) (a) A registered sprinkler fitter shall complete continuing
2	education requirements established by rule of the administrator.

- (b) A sprinkler fitter shall apply to renew his or her registration annually. The administrator shall renew, for a period of one year, a sprinkler fitter registration upon receipt of a completed renewal application and a renewal fee as determined by the administrator. In years that the fire and safety code is revised, a sprinkler fitter shall also successfully complete a revised examination in order to renew his or her registration.
- 10 (6) The administrator may promulgate rules as necessary for the implementation of this section.
- SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.".
