#### **Bill Summary**

The bill specifies that a physician, podiatrist, or advanced practice nurse verifying a person's disability for purposes of obtaining an identifying license plate or parking placard may be licensed in another state that shares a common border with Colorado.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** 42-3-204 (1) (g), Colorado Revised Statutes, is 3 amended to read: 4 42-3-204. Parking privileges for persons with disabilities -5 **applicability - rules - repeal.** (1) As used in this section: 6 (g) "Professional" means a physician licensed to practice medicine 7 or practicing medicine pursuant to section 12-36-106 (3) (i), C.R.S., A 8 PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT LICENSED PURSUANT TO SECTION 12-36-107.4, 9 C.R.S., a podiatrist licensed under article 32 of title 12, C.R.S., or an 10 advanced practice nurse registered pursuant to section 12-38-111.5, 11 C.R.S., OR A PHYSICIAN, PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT, PODIATRIST, OR 12 ADVANCED PRACTICE NURSE AUTHORIZED TO PRACTICE PROFESSIONALLY 13 BY ANOTHER STATE THAT SHARES A COMMON BORDER WITH COLORADO. 14 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, 15 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate 16 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
