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**Summary of Amendments Made to the Bill After the 02/23/11 Legislative Council Staff Revised Fiscal Note Was Prepared (Amended by the House State, Veterans, and Military Affairs Committee 02/24/11)**

The House State, Veterans, and Military Affairs Committee Report makes several clarifying amendments to the bill. Staff consulted with Legislative Council Staff and both offices agreed that the amendments do not impact the appropriation status of the bill.

**Amendments/Appropriation Status**

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause to transfer the Supportive Housing and Homeless Program from the Department of Human Services (DHS) to the Department of Local Affairs (DOLA). Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$20,049,413 federal funds for informational purposes in FY 2011-12 to DOLA for the expenses associated with administering the Supportive Housing and Homeless Program. Additionally, **J.001** contains an offsetting provision reducing informational appropriations of federal funds to DHS by an equal amount.
