A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING THE SALES TAX EXEMPTION FOR PURCHASES OF MEDICAL
102 EQUIPMENT.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill specifies that "durable medical equipment" and "mobility enhancing equipment" are exempt from sales tax and defines those particular terms.

1	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
2	SECTION 1. 39-26-717, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended

4	39-26-717. Drugs and medical and therapeutic devices -
5	definitions. (1) The following shall be exempt from taxation under the
6	provisions of part 1 of this article:
7	(a) All sales of drugs dispensed in accordance with a prescription;
8	(b) All sales of insulin in all its forms dispensed pursuant to the
9	direction of a licensed physician;
10	(c) All sales of glucose useable for treatment of insulin reactions;
11	(d) All sales of urine- and blood-testing kits and materials;
12	(e) All sales of insulin measuring and injecting devices, including
13	hypodermic syringes and needles;
14	(f) All sales of prosthetic devices;
15	(g) (I) ALL SALES OF OXYGEN DELIVERY EQUIPMENT AND
16	DISPOSABLE MEDICAL SUPPLIES RELATED TO OXYGEN DELIVERY DISPENSED
17	PURSUANT TO A PRESCRIPTION.

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1	(B) IS APPROPRIATE FOR USE IN A HOME, IN A PERSON'S
2	COMMUNITY, OR IN A MOTOR VEHICLE;
3	(C) IS NOT GENERALLY USED BY PERSONS WITH NORMAL MOBILITY;
4	AND
5	(D) DOES NOT INCLUDE ANY MOTOR VEHICLE OR EQUIPMENT ON
6	A MOTOR VEHICLE NORMALLY PROVIDED BY A MOTOR VEHICLE
7	MANUFACTURER.
8	(II) "MOBILITY ENHANCING EQUIPMENT" INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT
9	LIMITED TO, WHEELCHAIRS AND WHEELCHAIR COMPONENTS OR
10	ACCESSORIES, WALKING AIDS SUCH AS CRUTCHES, CANES, OR WALKERS,
11	GRAB BARS, TRAPEZE BARS, LIFT CHAIRS, PATIENT LIFTS, MOTORIZED
12	CARTS, SCOOTERS, CONTROLS THAT ARE INSTALLED ON MOTOR VEHICLES,
13	AND ANY RELATED ACCESSORIES FOR SUCH ITEMS.

26	SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date -
27	applicability. (1) This act shall take effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day

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1	following the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment
2	of the general assembly (August 10, 2011, if adjournment sine die is on
3	May 11, 2011); except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to
4	section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an
5	item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item,
6	section, or part shall not take effect unless approved by the people at the
7	general election to be held in November 2012 and shall take effect on the
8	date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
9	(2) The provisions of this act shall apply to purchases of medical

(2) The provisions of this act shall apply to purchases of medical equipment on or after the applicable effective date of this act.

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
