**Amendments/Appropriation Status**

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause. Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add provisions decreasing the appropriation to the Department of Revenue, Division of Motor Vehicles, by 38,644 cash funds and 0.1 FTE for FY 2010-11 and decreasing the 2011 Long Bill appropriation to the Department of Revenue, Division of Motor Vehicles, by \$226,556 cash funds and 0.5 FTE. The source of the cash funds is the Defensive Driving School Fund.

**Bill Sponsor Amendments**

Staff is not aware of any sponsor amendments to be offered.

**Points to Consider**

Staff estimates that the Defensive Driving School Fund will have approximately \$126,000 in fund balance at the time the law goes into effect. The bill does not have any provision for the ultimate disposition of the moneys in the fund at the time the fund is repealed.
