After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB11-173 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 3, line 8, strike "and instantaneously" and strike
2 "by radio".

3 Page 4, strike lines 17 through 27 and substitute:

4 "(d) Each school district, on or before July 1, 2009, to start to
5 develop ~~in conjunction with local fire departments, local law enforcement~~
6 ~~agencies, local emergency medical service personnel, local mental health~~
7 ~~organizations, and local public health agencies, collectively referred to in~~
8 ~~this subsection (4) as "community partners"~~; a school safety, readiness,
9 and incident management plan, INCLUDING, TO THE EXTENT POSSIBLE,
10 EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS, that coordinates with any statewide or
11 local homeland ~~security~~ EMERGENCY OPERATION plans. ~~and that~~, IN
12 DEVELOPING THE PLAN, A SCHOOL DISTRICT MAY COLLABORATE WITH
13 LOCAL FIRE DEPARTMENTS, STATE AND LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT
14 AGENCIES, LOCAL 911 AGENCIES, LOCAL EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE
15 PERSONNEL, LOCAL MENTAL HEALTH ORGANIZATIONS, LOCAL PUBLIC
16 HEALTH AGENCIES, LOCAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PERSONNEL, AND
17 LOCAL OR REGIONAL HOMELAND SECURITY PERSONNEL, WHICH ENTITIES
18 ARE COLLECTIVELY REFERRED TO IN THIS SUBSECTION (4) AS "COMMUNITY
19 PARTNERS". THE SCHOOL SAFETY, READINESS, AND INCIDENT
20 MANAGEMENT PLAN SHALL, at a minimum, ~~identifies~~ IDENTIFY for each
21 public school in the school district:".

1 Page 5, line 10, strike "REGULAR".

2 Page 5, strike lines 20 through 27 and substitute:

3 **"response.** (1) THE SCHOOL RESPONSE FRAMEWORK CREATED IN SECTION
4 22-32-109.1 (4), C.R.S., SETS FORTH THE FRAMEWORK FOR SCHOOL
5 EMERGENCY INCIDENT RESPONSE AND EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS,
6 INCLUDING EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS. PURSUANT TO THE SCHOOL
7 RESPONSE FRAMEWORK, EMERGENCY RESPONSE PERSONNEL ARE
8 COMMUNITY PARTNERS WITH SCHOOLS. AS PART OF ITS DUTY TO
9 REGULARLY INSPECT SCHOOL".

10 Strike page 6.

11 Page 9, strike lines 23 through 27 and substitute:

12 "(j) PROVIDE INFORMATION AND EXPERTISE, TO THE EXTENT
13 POSSIBLE, REGARDING INTEROPERABLE AND EMERGENCY
14 COMMUNICATIONS PLANNING, TECHNOLOGY, TRAINING, AND FUNDING
15 OPPORTUNITIES TO STATE, REGIONAL, TRIBAL, AND LOCAL AGENCIES AND
16 EMERGENCY PERSONNEL AND ALL OTHER STAKEHOLDERS, INCLUDING BUT
17 NOT LIMITED TO PUBLIC, PRIVATE AND NONGOVERNMENTAL
18 ORGANIZATIONS."

19 Page 10, strikes lines 1 through 4.
