Reason for the Update

The Department of Revenue has indicated that they need the appropriation in FY 2010-11 rather than in FY 2011-12 as indicated in the Legislative Staff Revised Fiscal Note dated February 18, 2011, in order to ensure that the Department's information systems are prepared to implement the fee changes required in the bill. JBC staff has discussed this with Legislative Council Staff and they agree with this assessment and will update the fiscal note when necessary.

Amendments/Appropriation Status

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause. Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$5,480 General Fund to the Department of Revenue, Information Technology Division for FY 2010-11, for reprogramming of the International Registry Program for commercial vehicles. Of this amount, \$1,480 is reappropriated to the Governor - Lieutenant Governor - State Planning and Budgeting, Office of Information Technology. **J.001** also adds a provision appropriating \$1,776 cash funds from the Colorado State Titling and Registration (CSTAR) Account of the Highway Users Tax Fund in FY 2010-11, to update the CSTAR System. This amount is reappropriated to the Governor - Lieutenant Governor - State Planning and Budgeting, Office of Information Costate Planning and Budgeting, Office of Information for State Planning and Budgeting, Office of Information - State Planning - State P
