## Summary of Amendments Made to the Bill After the 05/03/11 Legislative Council Staff Revised Fiscal Note Was Prepared (Amended by the House Economic and Business Development Committee 05/04/11)

The House Economic and Business Development Committee Report inserts bioscience as an industry eligible for transfers from state income tax withholdings to a specified cash fund. Legislative Council and Joint Budget staff concur that the amendment does not impact the appropriation status of the bill for FY 2011-12.

## **Reason for the Update**

The Senate Appropriations Committee Report dated 04/15/11 changed the effective date of the bill from FY 2011-12 to FY 2012-13.

### **Amendments/Appropriation Status**

The bill neither requires nor contains an appropriation clause for FY 2011-12.

### **Bill Sponsor Amendments**

Staff is not aware of any sponsor amendments to be offered.

### **Points to Consider**

Although this bill does not require a General Fund appropriation for FY 2011-12, it is projected to require a General Fund appropriation of \$11,733 and 0.2 FTE in FY 2012-13. Additionally, the bill diverts an estimated \$5.1 million in FY 2013-14 that would otherwise be credited to the General Fund.
