TITLE: CONCERNING THE DESIGNATION OF THE PRESIDING OFFICER OF THE UNIVERSITY OF COLORADO HOSPITAL AUTHORITY'S BOARD OF DIRECTORS.**Summary of Legislation**

Currently, state law requires that the chancellor of the University of Colorado Health Sciences Center serve as the presiding officer of the board of directors of the University of Colorado Hospital Authority. This bill authorizes the president of the University of Colorado to appoint the presiding officer.

Background

The University of Colorado Hospital Authority is a quasi-governmental and corporate entity charged with the mission of operating a teaching hospital for the benefit of the health sciences schools in the university system, and providing care to the medically indigent. The authority is governed by an 11-member board appointed by the regents. The board of directors controls the day-to-day operations of the University of Colorado Hospital.

Assessment

The bill will not change the expenditures or revenue of state government, or the expenses or revenue of statutory public entities such as the authority. It merely changes how a board officer is selected. For these reasons, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.
