## **Summary of Legislation**

This bill authorizes the Colorado Public Utilities Commission (PUC) to promulgate rules that exempt customers from a utility's tiered rate plans for electric utility service based on a customer's medical condition or use of an essential life support device.

## **State Expenditures**

No expenditure increase is expected as a result of this bill.

**Department of Regulatory Agencies, Public Utilities Commission**. Under this bill, the PUC is authorized to promulgate rules to exempt customers with qualifying medical conditions from a utility's tiered rate plans. It is anticipated that the bill would be implemented through a small rate case, and that this could be accomplished within existing appropriations.
