Bill Summary

The bill creates the world war II special license plate to identify that the owner of the motor vehicle is a veteran of world war II. The owner would pay the normal fees for license plates.

2	SECTION 1. 42-3-213 (1) (a), Colorado Revised Statutes, is

5	(1) (a) The department shall issue one or more sets of special license
6	plates to the following persons who own a truck that does not exceed
7	sixteen thousand pounds empty weight, a passenger car, a motorcycle, or
8	a noncommercial or recreational vehicle:
9	(XXII) A VETERAN OF WORLD WAR II.
10	SECTION 2. 42-3-213 (1) (b) (II), Colorado Revised Statutes, is
11	amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SUB-SUBPARAGRAPH to

8	BETWEEN DECEMBER 7, 1941, AND SEPTEMBER 2, 1945.
9	SECTION 4. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act
10	shall take effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
11	ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August
12	10, 2011, if adjournment sine die is on May 11, 2011); except that, if a
13	referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the
14	state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act
15	within such period, then the act, item, section, or part shall not take effect
16	unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
17	November 2012 and shall take effect on the date of the official
18	declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
