

<u>Summary of Amendments Made to the Bill After the 01/21/11 Legislative Council Staff Fiscal</u> <u>Note Was Prepared (Amended by the Senate State, Veterans & Military Affairs Committee</u> <u>01/24/11)</u>

The Senate State, Veterans & Military Affairs Committee Report dated January 24, 2011 broadened the number of veterans eligible for the special license plate by making eligible those who served in the military between September 16, 1940 and July 25, 1947. Staff assessment is that this amendment does <u>not</u> have a fiscal impact on the bill. Legislative Council Staff agrees with this assessment.

Amendments/Appropriation Status

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause. Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$2,960 cash funds from the Colorado State Titling and Registration Account of the Highway Users Tax Fund to the Department of Revenue, Information Technology Division, for FY 2011-12 to program the Department's computer systems to implement the bill. The amendment further appropriates those moneys to the Governor - Lieutenant Governor - State Planning and Budgeting, Office of Information Technology, for FY 2011-12, for programming services provided to the Department of Revenue related to the implementation of this bill. Amendment **J.001** further adds a provision appropriating \$9,080 cash funds from the License Plate Cash Fund to the Department of Revenue, Division of Motor Vehicles for FY 2011-12 for the purchase of license plates from the Department of Corrections, Correctional Industries.
