A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING THE VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION DESIGNATION**
102 **BENEFITING THE MILITARY FAMILY RELIEF FUND THAT APPEARS**
103 **ON THE STATE INDIVIDUAL INCOME TAX RETURN FORMS, AND, IN**
104 **CONNECTION THEREWITH, EXTENDING THE PERIOD FOR THE**
105 **CONTRIBUTION DESIGNATION.**

Bill Summary

shall include a line allowing individual taxpayers to make a voluntary contribution to the military family relief fund.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** 39-22-3001, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended
3 to read:

4 **39-22-3001. Voluntary contribution designation - procedure.**

5 For income tax years commencing on or after ~~January 1, 2008~~ JANUARY
6 1, 2011, but prior to ~~January 1, 2011~~ JANUARY 1, 2016, the Colorado state
7 individual income tax return form shall contain a line whereby each
8 individual taxpayer may designate the amount of the contribution, if any,
9 the individual wishes to make to the military family relief fund created in
10 section 28-3-1502, C.R.S.

11 **SECTION 2.** 39-22-3003, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended
12 to read:

13 **39-22-3003. Repeal of part.** This part 30 is repealed, effective
14 ~~January 1, 2012~~ JANUARY 1, 2017, unless the voluntary contribution to the
15 military family relief fund is continued or reestablished by the general
16 assembly acting by bill prior to said date.

17 **SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
18 shall take effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
19 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August
20 10, 2011, if adjournment sine die is on May 11, 2011); except that, if a
21 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the
22 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act
23 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part shall not take effect
24 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in

1 November 2012 and shall take effect on the date of the official
2 declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
