The bill, as introduced, does not contain an appropriation clause. The FY 2011-12 Long Bill has not yet been introduced. If this bill passes prior to the introduction of the Long Bill, the above adjustments will be reflected in the FY 2011-12 Long Bill. If this bill has not passed prior to the introduction of the FY 2011-12 Long Bill, the fiscal impact of this bill will not be reflected in the FY 2011-12 Long Bill. In this instance, this bill will require an appropriation clause that adjusts the FY 2011-12 Long Bill appropriations accordingly.

#### **Bill Sponsor Amendments**

Staff is not aware of any sponsor amendments to be offered.

#### **Points to Consider**

- 1. The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has introduced a balanced budget package for FY 2010-11 based on the December 2010 Office of State Planning and Budgeting revenue forecast. The JBC has included as part of its FY 2010-11 plan the General Fund revenue increase that would result from the passage of this bill, as introduced. This bill is estimated to result in the transfer of \$2,086,643 to the General Fund in FY 2010-11. It this bill does not become law, General Fund expenditures will need to be reduced elsewhere in the FY 2010-11 budget by \$2,086,643.
- 2. This bill is also part of the Joint Budget Committee's FY 2011-12 budget balancing package. If this bill does not pass, General Fund expenditures will need to be reduced elsewhere in the FY 2011-12 budget by \$4.3 million.
