After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB11-1251 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 2, strike lines 18 through 23 and substitute:

2 "(III) A LAW ENFORCEMENT VEHICLE MAY HAVE ITS WINDOWS,
3 EXCEPT THE WINDSHIELD, TREATED IN SUCH A MANNER SO AS TO ALLOW
4 LESS THAN TWENTY-SEVEN PERCENT LIGHT TRANSMITTANCE ONLY FOR
5 THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING A VALID LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICE. A LAW
6 ENFORCEMENT VEHICLE WITH SUCH WINDOW TREATMENT SHALL NOT BE
7 USED FOR ANY TRAFFIC LAW ENFORCEMENT OPERATIONS, INCLUDING
8 OPERATIONS CONCERNING ANY OFFENSE IN ARTICLE 4 OF THIS TITLE. FOR
9 PURPOSES OF THIS SUBPARAGRAPH (III), "LAW ENFORCEMENT VEHICLE"
10 MEANS A VEHICLE OWNED OR LEASED BY A STATE OR LOCAL LAW
11 ENFORCEMENT AGENCY. THE TREATMENT OF THE WINDSHIELD OF A LAW
12 ENFORCEMENT VEHICLE IS SUBJECT TO THE LIMITS DESCRIBED IN
13 PARAGRAPH (b) OF THIS SUBSECTION (1).".
