A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING A REDUCTION TO THE JUVENILE DETENTION BED CAP, 102 AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

Bill Summary

Beginning with fiscal year 2011-12, the juvenile detention bed cap is reduced from 479 beds to 422 beds.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

1	SECTION 1. 19-2-1201, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended
2	to read:
3	19-2-1201. Juvenile detention bed cap. (1) For the fiscal year
4	2003-04 and each fiscal year thereafter THROUGH FISCAL YEAR 2010-11,
5	the number of available juvenile detention beds statewide shall be limited
6	to four hundred seventy-nine.
7	(2) For the fiscal year 2011-12 and each fiscal year
8	THEREAFTER, THE NUMBER OF AVAILABLE JUVENILE DETENTION BEDS
9	STATEWIDE SHALL BE LIMITED TO FOUR HUNDRED TWENTY-TWO.
10	SECTION 2. Appropriation - adjustments in the 2011 long
11	bill. For the implementation of this act, appropriations made in the
12	annual general appropriation act for the fiscal year beginning July 1,
13	2011, shall be adjusted as follows:
14	(1) The appropriation from the general fund, to the department of
15	human services, executive director's office, is decreased by ninety-two
16	thousand two hundred sixty dollars (\$92,260).
17	(2) The appropriation from the general fund, to the department of
18	human services, division of youth corrections, is decreased by nine
19	hundred eighty-six thousand five hundred sixty-eight dollars (\$986,568)
20	and 8.3 FTE.
21	SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
22	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
23	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
