Amendments/Appropriation Status

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause. Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$12,136 General Fund and 0.2 FTE to the Department of Personnel and Administration for FY 2011-12.

Bill Sponsor Amendments

Sponsor amendment **L.004** (attached) eliminates the provision that an agency or political subdivision of the state must require an applicant for public benefits to produce additional documentation that verifies the person's lawful presence in the United States. Sponsor amendment **L.004** eliminates the bill's fiscal impact. If **L.004 is adopted**, **J.001 should** <u>not</u> be adopted.

Points to Consider

The general appropriations bill for FY 2011-12 has not yet been introduced. This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$12,136 for FY 2011-12, reducing the amount of General Fund available for other existing programs.
