<u>Summary of Amendments Made to the Bill After the 04/28/11 Legislative Council Staff</u> <u>Revised Fiscal Note Was Prepared</u>

JBC Staff Concurrence with Legislative Council Staff Fiscal Note



Reason for the Update

The Legislative Council Staff Revised Fiscal Note dated April 28, 2011 indicates that expansion of teen pregnancy and dropout prevention services will create savings in the Medicaid program of approximately \$56,648 total funds (including \$28,324 General Fund) in FY 2011-12. Based on further analysis, the Medicaid program savings have been reduced to \$53,470 total funds (including \$26,735 General Fund) in FY 2011-12. When other costs for the program are included, staff now estimates the total FY 2011-12 fiscal impact of the bill to be \$644,440 instead of the \$641,262 indicated in the Legislative Council Staff Revised Fiscal Note. The table below shows staff's revised estimates for the bill.

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Amendments/Appropriation Status

The bill includes an appropriation clause that assumed \$56,648 in Medicaid savings instead of the \$53,470 in Medicaid savings now estimated. The current appropriation clause also contains a technical error. Therefore, staff has prepared amendment **J.004** (attached) to change the existing clause to reflect the appropriation described in the table below.
