Amendments/Appropriation Status

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause. Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$194,377 cash funds from the Stationary Sources Control Fund and 0.2 FTE to the Department of Public Health and Environment, Air Pollution Control Division, in accordance with the Legislative Council Staff Revised Fiscal Note dated April 28, 2011.

Bill Sponsor Amendments

Sponsor amendment **L.003** (attached) clarifies that funds collected by the Department that will be passed through to third party contractors will be deposited into the Stationary Sources Control Fund. The appropriation clause discussed above assumes adoption of amendment L.003 because amendment L.003 is necessary to allow the Department to spend the money collected for payment to the contractors.
