Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB11-159 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 11, after line 4 insert:

2 **"SECTION 10. Appropriation.** (a) In addition to any other
3 appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the
4 creative industries cash fund created in section 24-48.5-301 (2) (a),
5 Colorado Revised Statutes, not otherwise appropriated, to the
6 governor-lieutenant governor-state planning and budgeting, for allocation
7 to the economic development programs division, Colorado office of film,
8 television, and media, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2011, the sum
9 of two hundred ninety-three thousand dollars (\$293,000) cash funds and
10 4.5 FTE, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the implementation
11 of this act.

12 (b) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby
13 appropriated, out of any moneys in the Colorado travel and tourism
14 promotion fund created in section 24-49.7-106 (1), Colorado Revised
15 Statutes, not otherwise appropriated, to the governor-lieutenant
16 governor-state planning and budgeting, for allocation to the economic
17 development programs division, Colorado promotion - Colorado welcome
18 centers, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2011, the sum of five
19 hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) cash funds and 3.3 FTE, or so much
20 thereof as may be necessary, for the implementation of this act.

21 (c) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby

1 appropriated, out of any moneys in the Colorado travel and tourism
2 promotion fund created in section 24-49.7-106 (1), Colorado Revised
3 Statutes, not otherwise appropriated, to the governor-lieutenant
4 governor-state planning and budgeting, for allocation to the economic
5 development programs division, Colorado promotion - other program
6 costs, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2011, the sum of fourteen
7 million four hundred forty-three thousand dollars (\$14,443,000) cash
8 funds and 4.0 FTE, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the
9 implementation of this act.

10 (d) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby
11 appropriated, out of any moneys in the creative industries cash fund
12 created in section 24-48.5-301 (2) (a), Colorado Revised Statutes, not
13 otherwise appropriated, to the governor-lieutenant governor-state
14 planning and budgeting, for allocation to the economic development
15 programs division, council on the arts, for the fiscal year beginning July
16 1, 2011, the sum of one million one hundred seventy-two thousand dollars
17 (\$1,172,000) cash funds and 2.0 FTE, or so much thereof as may be
18 necessary, for the implementation of this act.

19 (e) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby
20 appropriated, out of any moneys in the innovative higher education
21 research fund created in section 23-19.7-104 (1), Colorado Revised
22 Statutes, not otherwise appropriated, to the department of higher
23 education, for allocation to the Colorado commission on higher
24 education, special purpose, distribution to higher education competitive
25 research authority, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2011, the sum of
26 two million fifty-one thousand dollars (\$2,051,000) cash funds, or so
27 much thereof as may be necessary, for the implementation of this act.

28 **SECTION 11. Appropriation - adjustments in long bill.** (1)
29 For the implementation of this act, appropriations made in the annual
30 general appropriation act for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2011, shall
31 be adjusted as follows:

32 (a) The cash funds appropriation from the bioscience discovery
33 evaluation cash fund created in section 24-48.5-108 (5) (a), Colorado
34 Revised Statutes, to the governor-lieutenant governor-state planning and
35 budgeting, economic development programs division, for bioscience
36 discovery evaluation, is increased by sixty-seven thousand dollars
37 (\$67,000).

1 (b) The cash funds appropriation from the local government
2 limited gaming impact fund created in section 12-47.1-1601 (1) (a),
3 Colorado Revised Statutes, to the department of local affairs, division of
4 local governments, field services, for local government limited gaming
5 impact grants, is decreased by two million four hundred ninety-one
6 thousand dollars (\$2,491,000).".

7 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

8 Page 1, line 105, strike "CONSTITUTION." and substitute "CONSTITUTION,
9 AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.".

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
