be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on <u>Appropriations</u> with favorable recommendation:
Amend printed bill, page 2, line 10, strike "A" and substitute "AN EXPANDABLE DUAL-LANE TRANSPORT".
Page 2, strike lines 16 through 18 and substitute "ISSUE A PERMIT TO APERSON WHO HAS BEEN HELD BY AN ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE TO HAVE DISOBEYED PERMIT RESTRICTIONS OR TO HAVE VIOLATED THIS SECTION OF RULES PROMULGATED UNDER THIS SECTION IN A HEARING HELD IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 4 OF TITLE 24, C.R.S.".
Page 3, line 18, strike "LOWEST SIZE AND WEIGHT" and substitute "SMALLEST DIMENSIONS".
Page 3, line 24, strike "UPON ENTERING" and substitute "AT THE NEAREST POINT WHERE THE SHIPMENT ENTERS THE STATE, AT A LOCATION SPECIFIED BY THE COLORADO STATE PATROL,".
Page 3, line 25, strike "COLORADO".
Page 4, strike line 8 and substitute "HOURS.".
Page 4, strike lines 17 through 23 and substitute:
" SECTION 2. 42-4-510(11)(a)(IV), Colorado Revised Statutes

is amended to read:

42-4-510. Permits for excess size and weight and for manufactured homes - rules - repeal. (11) (a) The department of transportation, the motor carrier services division of the department of revenue, or the Colorado state patrol may charge permit applicants permit fees as follows:

(IV) Special permits for structural, oversize, or overweight moves requiring extraordinary action or moves involving weight in excess of two hundred thousand pounds, one hundred twenty-five dollars for a permit for a single trip, INCLUDING A SUPER-LOAD PERMIT ISSUED UNDER SUBSECTION (1.7) OF THIS SECTION; EXCEPT THAT A SUPER-LOAD PERMIT FEE IS FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS;".
