<u>Summary of Amendments Made to the Bill After the 02/22/11 Legislative Council Staff Fiscal</u> Note Was Prepared (Amended by the House Transportation Committee 02/23/11)

The House Transportation Committee Report dated February 23, 2011, changed the bill to specify that the design of the license plate, rather than being designed by the Type I Diabetes Foundation of Colorado now requires the license plate to indicate that the "owner of the motor vehicle to which the plate is attached supports research to cure Type I Diabetes".

This change will require the Department of Revenue to design the license plate, which increases the required appropriation as identified in the Legislative Council Staff Fiscal Noted dated February 22, 2011 by \$200 cash funds. JBC Staff and Legislative Council Staff agree with this assessment.

Reason for the Update

Amendments/Appropriation Status

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause. Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$2,960 cash funds from the Colorado State Titling and Registration Account of the Highway Users Tax Fund to the Department of Revenue, Information Technology Division, for FY 2011-12 to program the Department's computer systems to implement the bill. The amendment further reappropriates those moneys to the Governor - Lieutenant Governor - State Planning and Budgeting, Office of Information Technology, for FY 2011-12, for programming services provided to the Department of Revenue related to the implementation of this bill. Amendment **J.001** further adds a provision appropriating \$9,280 cash funds from the License Plate Cash Fund to the Department of Revenue, Division of Motor Vehicles for FY 2011-12 for the design and purchase of license plates from the Department of Corrections, Correctional Industries.
