# A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING CLARIFYING THE ELEMENTS OF THE CRIMINAL OFFENSE

102 OF CRIMINAL IMPERSONATION.

#### **Bill Summary**

The bill clarifies some of the elements of the offense of criminal impersonation.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

6	(a) Assumes a false or fictitious identity or LEGAL capacity, and

8	(a) (I) Marries, or pretends to marry, or to sustain the marriage
9	relation toward another without the connivance of the latter; or
10	(b) (II) Becomes bail or surety for a party in an action or
11	proceeding, civil or criminal, before a court or officer authorized to take
12	the bail or surety; or
13	(c) (III) Confesses a judgment, or subscribes, verifies, publishes,
14	acknowledges, or proves a written instrument which by law may be
15	recorded, with the intent that the same may be delivered as true; or
16	(b) ASSUMES A FALSE OR FICTITIOUS IDENTITY OR CAPACITY,
17	LEGAL OR OTHER, AND IN SUCH IDENTITY OR CAPACITY HE OR SHE:
18	(d) (I) $\frac{1}{10000000000000000000000000000000000$
19	falsely impersonated, might subject such person to an action or special
20	proceeding, civil or criminal, or to liability, charge, forfeiture, or penalty;

22	(e) (II) Does PERFORMS any other act with intent to unlawfully
23	gain a benefit for himself, HERSELF, or another or to injure or defraud
24	another.
25	(3) For the purposes of subsection $(1)$ of this section, using
26	FALSE OR FICTITIOUS PERSONAL IDENTIFYING INFORMATION, AS DEFINED
27	IN SECTION 18-5-901 (13), SHALL CONSTITUTE THE ASSUMPTION OF A

- 2 SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
- 3 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
- 4 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
