Bill Summary

The bill extends to June 30, 2017, the \$1 surcharge collected by each county clerk and recorder for each document received by the clerk

and recorder for recording or filing.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 1 2 **SECTION 1.** 30-10-421 (1) (b), Colorado Revised Statutes, is 3 amended to read: 4 **30-10-421. Filing surcharge - definitions.** (1) (b) On and after 5 July 1, 2004, and through June 30, 2012 2017, the county clerk and 6 recorder shall collect a surcharge of one dollar for each document 7 received for recording or filing in his or her office. The surcharge shall 8 be in addition to any other fees permitted by statute. 9 SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 10 shall take effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 11 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 12 10, 2011, if adjournment sine die is on May 11, 2011); except that, if a 13 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the 14 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act 15 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part shall not take effect 16 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 17 November 2012 and shall take effect on the date of the official 18 declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
