A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING PERSONNEL EMPLOYED TO OPERATE THE PUBLIC  
102 GOLFING CLUB AT NORTHEASTERN JUNIOR COLLEGE.

**Bill Summary**

The bill exempts from the state personnel system employment positions for the operation of the public golfing club owned and operated by Northeastern junior college.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** 24-50-135 (2) (c) and (2) (d), Colorado Revised  
3 Statutes, are amended, and the said 24-50-135 is further amended BY  
4 THE ADDITION OF A NEW SUBSECTION, to read:

5 **24-50-135. Exemptions from personnel system.** (2) (c) No later  
6 than December 31 of each year, the president of each educational  
7 institution shall submit a report to the state personnel director, in the form  
8 prescribed by the director, listing all positions at the educational  
9 institution that are exempt from the state personnel system in accordance  
10 with SUBSECTION (1) OF this section.

11 (d) No later than December 31 of each year, the executive director  
12 of the Colorado commission on higher education shall submit a report to  
13 the state personnel director, in the form prescribed by the director, listing  
14 all positions in the department of higher education, other than positions  
15 at educational institutions, that are exempt from the state personnel  
16 system in accordance with SUBSECTION (1) OF this section.

17 (3) POSITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT FOR THE OPERATION OF THE GOLF  
18 COURSE AND RESTAURANT THAT ARE OWNED AND OPERATED BY  
19 NORTHEASTERN JUNIOR COLLEGE AND OPEN TO THE PUBLIC, KNOWN  
20 COMMONLY AS THE "NORTHEASTERN 18" AND THE "PLAINSMAN GRILL  
21 AND STEAKHOUSE", AND ANY SUCCESSOR BUSINESSES, ARE EXEMPT FROM  
22 THE STATE PERSONNEL SYSTEM.

23 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
24 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
25 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
