2 SECTION 1. Part 2 of article 60 of title 23, Colorado Revised
3 Statutes, is amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION to

5 23-60-212. Northeastern junior college - golf course and 6 restaurant - positions of employment. POSITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT FOR 7 THE OPERATION OF THE GOLF COURSE AND RESTAURANT THAT ARE OWNED 8 AND OPERATED BY NORTHEASTERN JUNIOR COLLEGE AND OPEN TO THE 9 PUBLIC, KNOWN COMMONLY AS THE "NORTHEASTERN 18" AND THE "PLAINSMAN GRILL AND STEAKHOUSE", AND ANY SUCCESSOR BUSINESSES, 10 11 ARE EXEMPT FROM THE STATE PERSONNEL SYSTEM. 12 SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,

determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediatepreservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
