A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING PERSONNEL EMPLOYED TO OPERATE THE PUBLIC**
102 **GOLFING CLUB AT NORTHEASTERN JUNIOR COLLEGE.**

Bill Summary

The bill exempts from the state personnel system employment positions for the operation of the public golfing club owned and operated by Northeastern junior college.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** Part 2 of article 60 of title 23, Colorado Revised
3 Statutes, is amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION to
4 read:

5 **23-60-212. Northeastern junior college - golf course and**
6 **restaurant - positions of employment.** POSITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT FOR
7 THE OPERATION OF THE GOLF COURSE AND RESTAURANT THAT ARE OWNED
8 AND OPERATED BY NORTHEASTERN JUNIOR COLLEGE AND OPEN TO THE
9 PUBLIC, KNOWN COMMONLY AS THE "NORTHEASTERN 18" AND THE
10 "PLAINSMAN GRILL AND STEAKHOUSE", AND ANY SUCCESSOR BUSINESSES,
11 ARE EXEMPT FROM THE STATE PERSONNEL SYSTEM.

12 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
13 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
14 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
