A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING A REPEAL OF THE REQUIREMENT THAT A CERTAIN**
102 **NUMBER OF GROUP SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES BE ISSUED.**

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill repeals the requirement that each group special license plate be issued to a certain number of people, usually 3,000, before the department retires or stops issuing the plate. The bill also repeals the requirement that the proponents obtain commitments from at least 3,000 people before a bill is introduced to create a new special license plate.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** 42-3-207 (2), Colorado Revised Statutes, is
3 amended to read:

4 **42-3-207. Special plates - rules - new plates - retirement.**

5 (2) Before a bill is introduced in the general assembly that contains, or
6 any bill is amended to contain, a provision that establishes a new category
7 or type of group special license plate, the person, group, or association
8 proposing ~~such~~ THE special license plate shall submit to the department
9 a proposal for a group special license plate and certify ~~by March 1 of each~~
10 ~~year~~ that at least three thousand of such special plates are to be issued
11 within one year after the authorization of such plates. The department
12 shall verify that any proposed group special license plates meet the
13 three-thousand-plate requirement. ~~and shall submit a consolidated~~
14 ~~proposal, containing all proposed group special license plates that meet~~
15 ~~such plate requirement.~~

16 **SECTION 2.** 42-3-214 (7), Colorado Revised Statutes, is
17 amended to read:

18 **42-3-214. Special plates - alumni associations - retirement.**

19 (7) The DEPARTMENT SHALL RETIRE THE special ALUMNI license plates
20 authorized by this section ~~shall be retired~~ unless ~~such~~ THE plates have
21 been issued for at least five hundred vehicles by ~~March 1, 2011~~ JULY 1,
22 2016. A PERSON WHO WAS ISSUED A SPECIAL ALUMNI LICENSE PLATE ON
23 OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2016, MAY CONTINUE TO USE THE PLATE AFTER JULY
24 1, 2016.

25 **SECTION 3.** 42-3-222 (3) and (6), Colorado Revised Statutes,

2 person may apply for a support public education special license plate if
3 the person pays the taxes and fees required under this section and
4 provides to the department or an authorized agent a certificate, issued by
5 impact on education, inc., COLORADO LEGACY FOUNDATION, or its EITHER
6 ENTITY'S successor, confirming that ~~such~~ THE person has donated twenty
7 dollars to ~~impact on education, inc., EITHER ORGANIZATION or its EITHER~~
8 ENTITY'S successor. When receiving ~~such~~ THE donation, impact on
9 education, inc., COLORADO LEGACY FOUNDATION, OR EITHER ENTITY'S
10 SUCCESSOR, shall ask the donor to specify in writing which nonprofit
11 education organization qualified under paragraph (c) of this subsection
12 (3) should receive the moneys. Impact on education, inc., COLORADO
13 LEGACY FOUNDATION, or its EITHER ENTITY'S successor, shall compile and
14 provide to the donor and the department a list of organizations that the
15 entity has verified qualify for donations under paragraph (c) of this
16 subsection (3).

17 (b) ~~All the moneys collected by Impact on education, inc.,~~
18 COLORADO LEGACY FOUNDATION, or its EITHER ENTITY'S successor
19 ~~pursuant to this subsection (3) shall be used~~ USE THE MONEYS COLLECTED
20 UNDER THIS SUBSECTION (3) to support programs that focus on student
21 learning in public schools located in Colorado.

22 (c) Impact on education, inc., COLORADO LEGACY FOUNDATION,
23 OR EITHER ENTITY'S SUCCESSOR shall transmit the entire donation to the
24 nonprofit education organization pursuant to paragraph (a) of this
25 subsection (3) if the organization:

- 26 (I) Exists;
- 27 (II) Is affiliated with a school district or the state charter institute;

1 (III) Is a nonprofit entity exempt from federal income taxes
2 pursuant to section 501 (c) (3) of the federal "Internal Revenue Code of
3 1986", as amended; and

4 (IV) Agrees to spend all of the donation on programs that focus
5 on student learning in Colorado.

6 (d) ~~Moneys collected by Impact on education, inc., COLORADO~~
7 ~~LEGACY FOUNDATION, or its EITHER ENTITY'S successor pursuant to this~~
8 ~~subsection (3) shall not be used~~ USE THE MONEYS COLLECTED UNDER THIS
9 SUBSECTION (3) to support political parties, candidates for public office,
10 ballot initiatives, referenda, or any other political activities.

11 (6) The department may stop issuing the support public education
12 special license plate if three thousand license plates are not issued by July
13 1, 2016. A person WHO WAS ISSUED A SUPPORT PUBLIC EDUCATION
14 SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2016, may continue to use
15 the support public education special license plate after July 1, 2016.

16 **SECTION 4.** 42-3-224 (2) (a), Colorado Revised Statutes, is

18 **42-3-224. Special plates - Colorado "Kids First".** (2) (a) There
19 is hereby established the Colorado "Kids First" special license plate. The
20 department may stop issuing the Colorado "Kids First" special license
21 plate if three thousand license plates are not issued by July 1, 2016.
22 A person WHO WAS ISSUED A COLORADO "KIDS FIRST" SPECIAL LICENSE
23 PLATE ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2016, may continue to use the Colorado
24 "Kids First" special license plate after July 1, 2016.

1 (2) (b) The department may stop issuing the Italian-American heritage

3 1, 2011 2016. A person WHO WAS ISSUED AN ITALIAN-AMERICAN
4 HERITAGE SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2016, may
5 continue to use the Italian-American heritage special license plate after
6 July 1, 2011 2016.

7 **SECTION 6.** 42-3-227 (6), Colorado Revised Statutes, is

10 **authority.** (6) The department may stop issuing the Colorado horse

14 OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2016, may continue to use the Colorado horse

18 **42-3-228. Special plates - Colorado carbon fund.** (6) The
19 department may stop issuing the Colorado carbon fund special license
20 plate if three thousand license plates are not issued by July 1, 2011 2016.
21 A person WHO WAS ISSUED A COLORADO CARBON FUND SPECIAL LICENSE
22 PLATE ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2016, may continue to use the Colorado
23 carbon fund special license plate after July 1, 2011 2016.

27 hereby established the boy scouts centennial special license plate, which

22 AFTER JULY 1, 2016.
