Bill Summary

The bill requires the director of the division of registrations and the state examining and licensing boards to accept education, training, or service completed by an applicant for licensure or certification while serving in the military toward the qualifications required to receive the license or certification.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 1 2 SECTION 1. 24-34-102, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended 3 BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SUBSECTION to read: 4 24-34-102. Division of registrations - creation - duties of 5 division and department heads - license, registration, or certification 6 renewal, reinstatement, and endorsement - definitions. (8.5) THE 7 DIRECTOR AND EACH OF THE EXAMINING AND LICENSING BOARDS SHALL, 8 UPON PRESENTATION OF SATISFACTORY EVIDENCE BY AN APPLICANT FOR 9 CERTIFICATION OR LICENSURE, ACCEPT EDUCATION, TRAINING, OR SERVICE 10 COMPLETED BY AN INDIVIDUAL AS A MEMBER OF THE ARMED FORCES OR 11 RESERVES OF THE UNITED STATES, THE NATIONAL GUARD OF ANY STATE, 12 THE MILITARY RESERVES OF ANY STATE, OR THE NAVAL MILITIA OF ANY 13 STATE TOWARD THE QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED TO RECEIVE THE LICENSE 14 OR CERTIFICATION. 15 **SECTION 2. Effective date.** This act shall take effect July 1, 16 2011. 17 **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, 18 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate 19 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
