## Bill Summary

The bill adds to the list of highways on which longer vehicle combinations may operate in Colorado under the existing permitting
process used by the department of transportation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
SECTION 1. 42-4-505 (3), Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

42-4-505. Longer vehicle combinations. (3) The long combinations shall be limited to interstate highway 25, interstate highway 76, interstate highway 70 west of its intersection with state highway 13 in Garfield county, interstate highway 70 east of its intersection with U.S. highway 40 and state highway 26, the circumferential highways designated I-225 and I-270, and state highway 133 in Delta county from mile marker 8.9 to mile marker 9.7, U.S. HIGHWAY 34 FROM ITS JUNCTION WITH INTERSTATE HIGHWAY 25 TO THE KANSAS BORDER, U.S. HIGHWAY 36 FROM ITS JUNCTION WITH INTERSTATE HIGHWAY 70 TO THE KANSAS BORDER, U.S. HIGHWAY 40 FROM LIMON TO THE KANSAS BORDER, U.S. highway 50, U.S. highway 160 from Durango to the New Mexico border and from Del Norte to the Kansas border, U.S. highway 285 FROM PONCHA SpRINGS TO THE NEW MEXICO BORDER, U.S. HIGHWAY 287 from Limon to the New Mexico border, U.S. highway 385 from its Junction with U.S. highway 50 TO The Nebraska border, U.S. highway 491 from Cortez to the UTAh Border, state highway 71 FROM ORDWAY TO ITS JUNCTION WITH INTERSTATE HIGHWAY 76, AND ANY COUNTY ROADS THAT THE COMMISSIONERS OF THAT COUNTY DESIGNATE. The department of transportation shall promulgate rules and regulations to provide carriers with reasonable ingress to and egress from such designated highway segments.

SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act
