A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING THE CREATION OF A SMALL BUSINESS NAVIGATOR BY THE**
102 **SMALL BUSINESS ASSISTANCE CENTER UNDER THE OFFICE OF**
103 **ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT.**

Bill Summary

The bill requires the small business assistance center under the office of economic development to create a small business navigator to provide a single point of contact for small businesses in order to facilitate and assist small businesses by:

- ! Diagnosing problems;
- ! Making referrals to small business development centers, the business advancement center operated by the university of Colorado, or other such centers or organizations;
- ! Providing information regarding state government contracting offices and processes;
- ! Providing assistance with state rules; and
- ! Conducting any follow-up with the small business as needed.

The bill also requires the office of economic development to advise and provide guidance to the small business navigator.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1. Legislative declaration.** The general assembly
3 hereby finds and declares that the Colorado office of economic
4 development shall complete only those tasks specified in House Bill
5 11-1209, enacted in 2011, that the office can currently do at no cost and
6 shall then transition to other tasks as resources become available and as
7 such tasks become cost effective.

8 **SECTION 2.** 24-48.5-101 (3), Colorado Revised Statutes, is
9 amended to read:

10 **24-48.5-101. Colorado office of economic development -**
11 **creation.** (3) The Colorado office of economic development shall advise
12 and provide guidance to THE SMALL BUSINESS NAVIGATOR DESCRIBED IN
13 SECTION 24-48.5-102 AND SHALL ADVISE AND PROVIDE GUIDANCE TO
14 coordinate activities of small business development centers and the
15 business advancement center operated by the university of Colorado.

16 **SECTION 3.** 24-48.5-102 (1), Colorado Revised Statutes, is
17 amended to read:

18 **24-48.5-102. Small business assistance center.** (1) (a) In
19 addition to the powers and duties specified in section 24-48.5-101, the

1 Colorado office of economic development shall include the small
2 business assistance center, which shall provide comprehensive
3 information on the federal, state, and local requirements necessary to
4 begin a business and shall make this information available to the public.

5 (b) (I) THE SMALL BUSINESS ASSISTANCE CENTER SHALL ALSO
6 CREATE A SMALL BUSINESS NAVIGATOR THAT SHALL PROVIDE A SINGLE
7 POINT OF CONTACT FOR SMALL BUSINESSES IN ORDER TO FACILITATE AND
8 ASSIST SMALL BUSINESSES BY:

9 (A) DIAGNOSING PROBLEMS;

10 (B) PROVIDING INFORMATION AND STREAMLINING REFERRALS TO
11 SMALL BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT CENTERS, THE COLORADO CREDIT
12 RESERVE PROGRAM, THE FEDERAL SMALL BUSINESS CREDIT INITIATIVE, OR
13 OTHER SUCH CENTERS OR ORGANIZATIONS;

14 (C) PROVIDING INFORMATION REGARDING STATE GOVERNMENT
15 CONTRACTING OFFICES AND PROCESSES;

16 (D) PROVIDING ASSISTANCE WITH STATE RULES; AND

17 (E) CONDUCTING ANY FOLLOW-UP WITH THE SMALL BUSINESS AS
18 NEEDED.

19 (II) (A) ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 15, 2012, AND ON OR BEFORE
20 JANUARY 15 THROUGH JANUARY 15, 2016, THE COLORADO OFFICE OF
21 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE GENERAL
22 ASSEMBLY, WHICH REPORT SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NEED NOT BE LIMITED TO,
23 THE NUMBER OF SMALL BUSINESSES BEING SERVED BY THE SMALL
24 BUSINESS NAVIGATOR AND THE AVERAGE AMOUNT OF GRANT MONEYS
25 RECEIVED BY SMALL BUSINESSES THAT MADE USE OF THE SMALL BUSINESS
26 NAVIGATOR.

27 (B) THIS PARAGRAPH (b) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2016.

1 PRIOR TO SUCH REPEAL THE DEPARTMENT OF REGULATORY AGENCIES
2 SHALL REVIEW THE SMALL BUSINESS NAVIGATOR PROGRAM ESTABLISHED
3 IN THIS PARAGRAPH (b) PURSUANT TO SECTION 24-34-104 (47).

4 SECTION 4. 24-34-104 (47), Colorado Revised Statutes, is
5 amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW PARAGRAPH to read:

6 24-34-104. General assembly review of regulatory agencies
7 and functions for termination, continuation, or reestablishment.

8 (47) The following agencies, functions, or both, shall terminate on July
9 1, 2016:

10 (d) THE SMALL BUSINESS NAVIGATOR PROGRAM ESTABLISHED IN
11 SECTION 24-48.5-102 (1) (b).

12 SECTION 5. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
13 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
14 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
